DEFINITION OF COMMUNITY SERVICE

Community services are defined as services which are identified by an institution of higher education through formal or informal consultation with local non-profit, governmental, and community-based organizations, as designed to improve the quality of life for community residents, particularly low-income individuals, or to solve particular problems related to their needs. These services include:

- Such fields as health care, child care, literacy training, education (including tutorial services), welfare, social services, transportation, housing and neighborhood improvement, public safety, crime prevention and control, recreation, rural development, and community improvement;
- Work in service opportunities or youth corps as defined in Section 101 of the National and Community Service Act of 1990, and service in the agencies, institutions and activities designated in that Act;
- Support services for students with disabilities (including students with disabilities who are enrolled at the school); and
- Activities in which a FWS student serves as a mentor for such purposes as tutoring, supporting educational/recreational activities, counseling including career counseling.

Please Note:

- Part-time employees and college assistants are not eligible to become FWS supervisors.
- Full-time Research Foundation (RF) employees who are interested in becoming FWS supervisors must contact the FWS office.
